Please remember your child needs to have suncream applied before they come to school to avoid any chance of getting sunburnt. The sun is very dangerous and can cause lots of problems for delicate skin. There are lots of once a day applications or children can bring sun cream to school, but must only apply it to themselves and not share. Children need sun hats/caps. They must drink lots of water, and bring a water bottle to school.

We must also realise that the weather can change suddenly and suitable clothing and footwear for the changing weather should be worn.

Term Time Absence

It's that time of year again, parents will be planning summer breaks. I would like to remind you that term time absence policy has not changed in light of the recent High Court ruling. Walsall Council will still be issuing fixed penalty fines. The holiday dates for next year are on the back page. Please check and note the training dates.

If Direct Gov. make any changes, we will of course, let you know.

You do have the right to appeal against this decision once the paperwork has been issued. This can be done directly to Walsall Council.

All term time absences must be requested in writing to the Head Teacher. If you fail to request in this way, and you do take your child out of school medical evidence will be requested. If you are unable to provide medical evidence, your paperwork will be passed to the Education Welfare for non attendance at school.

The school now asks all parents to provide medical evidence for appointments in school time. We are also going to be adopting the guidance that parents will be asked for medical evidence if a child is away from school for more than three days.

Parents are also reminded that appointments where possible should be made at the end or beginning of the school day to avoid valuable core subject time being missed or interrupted.
